One of the main goals that our school has set this school year is the prevention and treatment of violence and bullying in the school environment. Our school has a ZERO TOLERANCE policy for incidents of violence and bullying that occur in the school environment.

This year our school participates in the Program of the Pedagogical Institute (PI) / Observatory for School Violence (PAVIS) "Prevention and management of bullying at school." The Program has been incorporated in the Unified Improvement Plan of the school, the Professional Learning Action Plan and the Health Education and Delinquency Prevention Action Plan. The aim of the Program is to empower the school to implement the Policy of the Ministry of Education, Sports and Youth for the prevention and management of incidents of bullying at school.

When investigating and managing incidents, the school treats all students with respect, including the ones who have bullied. Additionally, in order to prevent these incidents, the school ensures that monitoring during breaktime is carried out with attention, consistency, and efficiency.

Students who witness or are victims of bullying, should contact the class tutor or a member of the management administration staff so that the school can proceed with a thorough investigation of the incident.

The School would like your contribution in preventing and dealing with incidents of violence and bullying in the school environment.
